

## Support the Victims of Haiti with COTEDIH

On August 22, 2020, Tropical Storm Laura passed through Haiti, causing flooding in 32 communes across 6 departments.

21 people have been killed and another 5 people are still missing. This situation combined with structural, and institutional weaknesses has a long-term impact on several development sectors including food security, water, health and education.



3 million girls and boys who come from poor zones live now in very difficult conditions.

Despite efforts from different sectors, the situation of large numbers of children with the outbreak of COVID-19 and Storm Laura is becoming more critical. The political crisis which intensified during the Year 2018-2019, COVID-19, and Laura Storm have considerable negative effects on the already alarming situation of girls and boys, characterized by a state of chronic malnutrition affecting

more than 25% of children.



We can confess and in fact, we have found that COVID-19 has not caused many victims in Haiti in terms of disease, but its impact in northern countries for example in the USA, in France, in Italy, in Canada, etc. have increased food insecurity in Haiti, the lack of material and financial resources for the education of young people and children and completely paralyzed the tourist industry, the free market (import and export) and a withdrawal of significant humanitarian aid from international NGOs that used to support the Haitian Government and local NGOs. This has currently put more than 5 million people in food insecurity and 1.5 million children out of school.



Food shortages, the absence of electricity, drinking water, and public services, in general, seem to be rife everywhere.

Faced with this tragic situation, “La Cooperation des Théologiens Evangéliques pour le Développement Intégral de l’Homme (COTEDIH)” or in English “The cooperation of Evangelical Theologians for the

Integral Development of Human” would like to support many children, students and victims ‘families with food, education and homes construction in its intervention areas. It is in this sense that we take the opportunity to invite you and all our readers today to collaborate with COTEDIH to rehabilitate 10 homes of 10 victims’ families and return to school and feed 300 students in emergency humanitarian situations in Haiti.
